

"ScanRobot" and "Nainuwa" - Presenting the scanning robot and the virtual library system of *Treventus*, by *Max Kleiss, Treventus*

The presentation of the ScanRobot and the virtual library system "Nainuwa" offers an introduction into the technical details of the automatic scanning robot of the Austrian firm Treventus. Next to the demonstration of the ScanRobot, two software applications for the management of digitised metasources will be presented: first, the integrated workflow module "ScanGate" which enables the automatic local image processing on multiple scanning interfaces based on user-specific metadata handling; second, the virtual library system "Nainuwa" which offers a content management system with multiple display and search options as well as easy meta data enrichment and online publishing functionalities.
